To offer the public easier access to campaign finance information, all local candidates and loca committees will be required to file their campaign treasurer's reports online through the Volusia County Supervisor of Elections website, <a href="https://www.volusiaelections.gov">www.volusiaelections.gov</a> .				
The reporting system, which is provided to you at no cost, expedites filling out and filing of the required financial reports of contributions and expenditures.				
To access the reporting system, locate the <i>Candidates</i> header at the top of the home page. Click or <i>Candidate Log In</i> . This link will access the reporting system log-in page. Listed below will be your ID Number and password to access the reporting system. The Pin number is used to submit reports If you do not have access to the internet at home, you may visit your local library, or we will make a computer available for you in our office.

Follow the instructions contained in the <i>How to File Financial Reports Online</i> handout to enter your campaign contributions and expenditures, and to submit the report. You may start entering your data at any time during the reporting period. ( <i>The information is not available to the public until you actually submit the report</i> ) You may also enter your biographical information and download your photo. ( <i>This information will not be posted to the site until approved. Please, no derogatory statements.</i> )				

## **POLICY ON REVIEW OF REPORTS**

As the filing officer, we are responsible **only** to ensure that the reports are complete, not that they are **"correct."** However, our office does check the summary page for accuracy.

• For municipal offices, the Town/City Clerk is the filing officer.

## **POLICY ON LATE REPORTS**

State law requires the electronic report to be submitted no later than midnight of the day designated. If not received, a fine may be imposed per Florida Statute.

## **POLICY ON JUSTIFYING LATE REPORTS**

**Reports must be filed timely**. There are **no** justifiable reasons for filing late reports unless otherwise determined by the Florida Elections Commission. Power outages, malfunction of the computer and/or computer program failure are not valid and acceptable reasons for not filing timely.


